The Distinguished Gentlemen's Club (DGC) is a mentoring program that aims to empower young men, in grades 3rd through 12th, to become leaders in their communities. Established in 2009, DGC has been providing exceptional opportunities for enrichment and leadership development to youth in the Tri-Country area. Our program offers youth the chance to create their own unique experiences through a variety of educational and leadership activities, including small-group mentorship and peer cohorts. Our mission is to transform these young men into natural-born leaders, ready to take on the world. Our curriculum is tailored to key areas that we believe to be essential for youth development and preparation for the real world, such as college and career readiness, leadership, and healthy relationships.

## **CLUB ACTIVITIES**

#### **CLUB MEETINGS**

Every 2nd Saturday during the Club Year (Sept. - May) DGC has its monthly Club Meetings. These meetings are times when the mentors & mentees come together for the purpose of learning special skills based on the theme & curriculum of the month. There is normally a Parent Advisory Council meeting that happens simultaneously.

#### OUTINGS

We aren't always working! Sometimes, we get together for fun outings where our young men get to let loose and have a good time! These can include trips to the movies, parks, cookouts, or even trips.

#### COMMUNITY SERVICE PROJECTS

Community Service is a big part of being a member of the DGC. Our members have a yearly service requirement of 18 hours. These hours can be earned during group Community Service Projects or individually.
